

Whiz Kids2 Camp FAQ's

Q: Who is going to be there?

A: Middle schoolers who currently attend Whiz Kids2 are all invited to come! You may recognize students from your site, but have a chance to meet other friends from different Whiz Kids2 sites. Tutors (who love Whiz Kids as much as you) will be up there as cabin leaders to help you feel comfortable as well!

Q: Where do I sleep? How many people will be in my cabin?

A: You will sleep in cabins located throughout the camp. Boys and girls will be in different areas of the camp. There are between 6-8 beds in a cabin. There will be at least two adult leaders in your cabin and they will be your leaders for the weekend!

Q: Do I have to bring a sleeping bag?

A: There are bunk beds, with a bed/mattress for each person in your cabin! Pillows, sheets, blankets, and towels will also be provided so you don't need to bring a sleeping bag.

Q: I'm nervous about swimming, what should I do?

A: The pool is awesome and fun (and heated)! Bring a t-shirt to wear on top of a swim suit or shorts if that feels more comfortable. A lifeguard will be on duty during swim time.

Q: Will I know anyone in my cabin?

A: Hopefully! But if not, you will be placed in a gender specific cabin with students in your same grade (example: 6th grade girls will be placed in a cabin together. 7th grade boys will be in a cabin together).

Q: Are there places to change in my cabin?

A: Yes! There is a bathroom attached to your cabin that you can use to change!

Q: What are the bathrooms like?

A: There are bathrooms attached to your cabin. There is a sink/counter area as well as a shower stall and a bathroom stall.

Q: How will we get to camp?

A: We will have a chartered bus take us to and from camp.

Q: What will the food be like?

A: Each meal is different and delicious. Each meal is served to us and we sit around tables to eat. If you have food allergies, you'll be able to let us know that on your camp registration forms.

Q: What will we be doing throughout the weekend?

A: The schedule is a surprise (in the best way!). There are many different activities we do (both as a large group and as a cabin group). Club Time is a big part of camp as well (just like you have at your sites).

Q: How do my parents get a hold of me if there's an emergency?

A: There is no cell phone reception at Silver Cliff Ranch. We will provide the phone number of Silver Cliff Ranch if your parents or guardians need to get in touch with you for an emergency. More details on this will be provided for parents/guardians in the camp registration form.
