

Club Time Lesson #7 – Talking w/ Jesus

OBJECTIVE: Students will learn how to have a conversation with Jesus.

GAME: A good game idea would be telephone. It speaks to the idea that we can go right to God – we don't need someone to speak to Him for us.

READ & DISCUSS:

Today we're going to read a prayer written by a man named David. He was one of the bravest warriors and noblest Kings. More than that - he was a man after God's own heart, meaning he was ALWAYS talking with Jesus.

Read Psalms 86:1-7

- Who here has ever just wanted to scream and tell someone to listen to them because they weren't listening? (Let kids share)
- How does David start out his prayer? Does he use a special word or code to get God's attention? (*He just calls out to Him – Lord...*)
- Does He need someone else to talk to God for him? Do we need someone else to talk to God for us?
- What are some of the things David asks God? (v. 2, 3, 4)
- Have you ever asked God for those things?
- Verse 3 – David says he calls to God ALL DAY LONG, I don't know about you but that sounds like a long time, who here thinks they can talk for more than 1 Hour? 2 Hours? 4 Hours? 10 Hours? 20 Hours? WOW!

Let's read something else from **Philippians 4:6 – 7**

- What can we talk to God about?
- Verse 6 talks about giving thanks when we pray – why do you think that's important?
- What does verse 7 say will happen to us when we do this?

CLOSING THOUGHTS:

God gives us peace when we give Him all our concerns, desires, and needs. He gives this to us because He is faithful and He is able to handle anything we give to Him. God is always available to listen to you; you will never have to fight for Jesus' attention!
