

Whiz Kids Club Message #10 – Fall 2021 Online

Topic- Point:	APPROPRIATION: Jesus is alive and stands at the door knocking.
Text:	Revelation 3:20

Introduction:

*Play a game of pictionary using a whiteboard and dry erase marker, or the Zoom Whiteboard if you are proficient at it! Draw the following words, having them guess before moving to the next one: butterfly, tree, ice cream and door. Make the last word you draw **“door”**. Use the drawing of the door for the message.*

Imagine that your **life is like a house** with a front door. (*Quickly draw a house around the door*) There’s one difference though, there isn’t a doorknob on the outside, only on the inside. (**Erase the knob**) and quickly draw a tree, bird, etc., to show it’s the outside.

God made us with the ability to choose what or who we let into our lives. It’s up to us; we have that door knob to the inside of your house, it’s **our choice**.

Pair Share: What are some **good** things we could choose to let into our lives?

Body:

There’s someone great who is standing at the door to your life. Guess Who it is?

Read Revelation 3:20 (*Show the picture and scripture*)

It’s like Jesus is saying to us, ‘I’m knocking on the door to your **life!** I made you and I love you. I died for you so that nothing would separate you from eternal life with Me. If you let me into your life, we can be friends and live together. There’s no knob out here, so it’s up to you to **invite** Me in. I’ll never force My way in.

We’ll eat together, play together, and go to school together. Matter of fact, I’ll be with you wherever you are, in the good times and the bad. You can talk to Me anytime and I’ll hear you. I’ve got some exciting things we could do together’.

Conclusion:

What do you think Jesus would do if you **didn’t** invite Him into your life?

Would He will stay there knocking? Yes! He never gives up!

So, why not ask Him in now? (*Show the pic of opening your heart to Jesus*)

Let’s pray. As we have our heads bowed. You **might** want to invite Jesus in to your life. All you have to say is something like this, “I believe in you, Jesus, and I know that I need you. Thank You for loving me and forgiving me. I’m opening the door of my life; please come in. Amen.”

Action: Believe Jesus when He said. “I’ll never leave you or forsake you.” He won’t!
