Club Time Lesson #3 - A Loving God

OBJECTIVE: Students will learn what is means to love God and to be loved by God.

READ & DISCUSS:

Read ROMANS 5: 6 – 8

- What does verse say it means to sin?
- Who here has ever felt unloved because of something you did?
- Who here has ever disliked someone for something they did?
- Does God stop loving us when we sin? What does verse 8 say?
- What ways do we try to earn God's love?
- Can we earn God's love?
- If we believe that we can earn God's love by being good how can we ever know we've been good enough?

Read Romans 5: 9 – 11

We talked about this last semester too, but it is worth repeating! We can never be good enough to get right with God. That's why Jesus came to earth and died for our sin. His sacrifice made us right with God.
