

## Whiz Kids Club Message #8 – Fall 2021 Online

<b>Topic- Point:</b>	NEED: Sin separates us from God.
<b>Text:</b>	Mark 10:17, 19-22
<b>Introduction:</b>	
Hey you guys, check out these games played with red solo cups, I will show 2 of the 4 games on the video. ( <i>Show Video, pause after each game, addressing doing it perfectly on the 1<sup>st</sup> try</i> ) Looks fun, doesn't it?! "Did anyone get all the cups <u>flipped perfectly</u> on the 1 <sup>st</sup> try?" They <u>bounced</u> really good, but did they do it perfectly?	
<b>Body:</b> <i>Have the shoe box that says, "Leaving God Out", and the 6 labeled cups</i>	
Now, let's switch our brains over to what the Bible has for us today. The Bible says that <u>none of us are perfect</u> ; we've all fallen short of God's plan.	
Our story tells of a man who thought that wasn't true of him. He thought he was pretty perfect and his only problem was making sure he could live in heaven forever. Here is a picture of this young man, he was successful, smart, and may have looked a lot like the man in this picture. ( <i>Show picture of man and Jesus</i> )	
Read Mark 10:17 ( <i>Show picture scripture Mark 10:17</i> ) That's a good question! What do you think Jesus will say? Read Mark 10:19 Well, Jesus tells him that He can see the man knows the commandments.	
The commandments are laws God has given people to help them live good lives. These laws are about loving God more than anything else, and loving other people. Read Mark 10:20 The man claimed he had done this all his life. ( <i>Show checklist picture as you read Mark 10:20</i> ) Bring up Scripture slide and read verses 21-22.	
<b>Pair Share:</b> What is <u>one</u> of the ways this man wasn't perfect? What did he love more than God? Yeah, his money! He turned away from Jesus. How did Jesus feel toward him? Did Jesus walk away from him?	
<u>When we turn away from God and leave Him out of our lives, this is called sin.</u>	
<b>Conclusion:</b> <i>Show PowerPoint slides of wall being built – that represents sin and the wall built between us and God. Say this as you switch to each slide.</i>	
When we leave God out, 1 - We <b>turn away</b> from Him and then we might be <b>unkind</b> to others	
When we leave God out, 2 - We <b>say words that hurt</b> ... and we might hurt people's feelings	
When we leave God out, 3 - We act <b>selfish, dishonest</b> , and might be <b>mean</b>	
When we leave God out, 4 – We <b>forget</b> how much He loves us and we might tell a <b>lie</b>	
When we leave God out, 5 – We feel <b>ungrateful</b> , and it might make us feel <b>greedy</b> or <b>jealous</b>	
When we leave God out, 6 – We make <b>wrong choices</b> like <b>cheating</b>	
Let's have this wall <u>stand for</u> a barrier between us and God.	
Next week we'll hear the good news of how Jesus came to break down the barrier. <b>God doesn't want anything to separate us from Him!</b>
