

Club Time Lesson #12 – The Resurrection

OBJECTIVE: Students will learn about the resurrection.

GAME: (Please choose from folder)

READ & DISCUSS

- Have your parents ever told you something was going to happen (good or bad) but it took a long time for it to happen? How did you feel once it did?

Easter is kind of like that. Jesus said a lot of things to his followers. Some of them took a while to happen and it wasn't until they occurred that they remembered. So far we read about Jesus' arrest and trial. He was crucified and died. Then he was buried. He was placed in a tomb and a large stone was rolled over it. Now let's read what happens next.

Read Luke 24: 1 – 12

- Who can retell this in their own words?
- The angels reminded the women of things Jesus said. What did Jesus say would happen that *did* happen?
- How do we know the women believed what the angels told them about what happened to Jesus?
- What else could have happened to Jesus' body?

Peter was one of Jesus' closest followers and friends. Yet he went away, "wondering about what had happened."

- Do you think Peter doubted who Jesus was? Why or why not?

CLOSING THOUGHTS: Everything Jesus had said would happen to him did happen to him. The reason we celebrate Easter is because Jesus rising from death means we can believe everything he says is true - heaven, God, freedom from sin, having a new life in Him, being right with God. Easter is a great reminder that Jesus died the death we should have died so that anyone who believes in him can have eternal life!
